[57] CLAIM

I claim the ornamental design for a toilet plunger and brush holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top, and side perspective view of the toilet plunger and brush holder embodying the design of the present invention.

FIG. 2 is a left side view thereof, the side opposite being a mirror image of the side shown in FIG. 2.


FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof.


FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.


FIG. 5 is a front view in elevation thereof; and,





