

I claim the ornamental design for a toilet utensil holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of my swan design for a toilet utensil holder.

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of my design.


FIG. 4 is a side view in elevation of my design.


FIG. 5 is a rear view in elevation of my design; and,


FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of my design.


The parts shown in broken lines do not comprise a part of the design.


